Any Drummer who will be found practicing at any other hour than the time mentioned will be severely punished. The Adjutants of the Several Regiments are to pay for the Execution of it. The Use of Drums are as Signals to the Army and if every Drummer is allowed to beat at his pleasure, the Intention would be Defeated as it is impossible to distinguish whether they are beating for their own pleasure or a Signal for the Troops."
