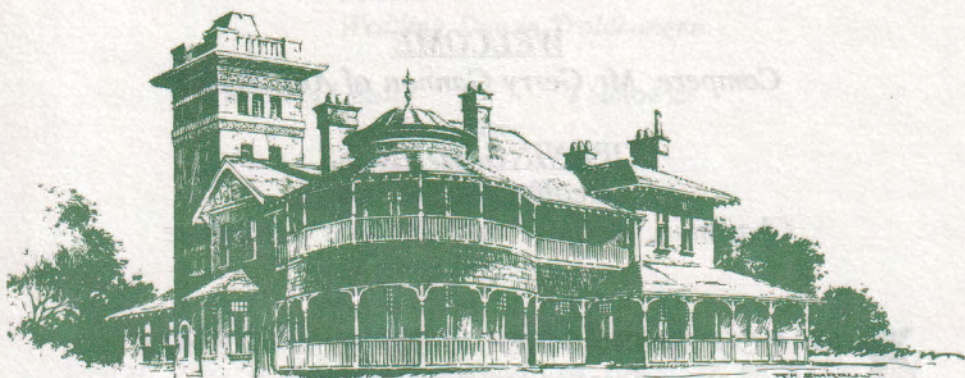

THE OLD OBSERVATORY

The National Trust Headquarters in West Perth, The Old Observatory, is the only remaining building of the original Perth Observatory complex.

It was constructed in 1987 by Colonial Architect George Temple-Poole for use as the staff offices and private residence of the Government Astronomer.

One of the most striking features of The Old Observatory is its great semi-circular verandahs which are aesthetically pleasing as well as functional, offering protection from the sun and giving access to magnificent views over Perth.
