New course for music students

THE WA Youth Orchestra Association (WAYO) and the WA Conservatorium of Music exhibitors programme have begun a new course for secondary school students.

Following a successful promotion enticing the community to find out about the instruments in the orchestra at the WAYO's Babies Proms, the percussion section was a resounding success.

An opportunity now exists for students to form a percussion ensemble with tuition and performance opportunities.

The ensemble is directed by Gary France, senior lecturer in percussion at the WA Conservatorium of Music, and consists of four to 15 players who will workshop and perform music written especially for the percussion ensemble.

Students are exposed to traditional techniques for tuned and untuned percussions as well as keyboard percussion.

The group meets on Fridays from 4pm to 7pm.

The last hour will be a concert class in a masterclass style, with young musicians discussing relevant topics of music performance.

Opportunities also exist for performances at public concerts presented by the WAYO at various venues during the year.
