## NAT ADDERLEY QUINTET

When a major Jazz Festival is looking for a topline band, the name Nat Adderley quickly comes to the fore. Two years ago he first played Montsalvat, since then Nat's group has played New Orleans...Newport... Montreal... Northsea... has recently toured Japan and comes to the Vic Health Montsalvat Jazz Festival from Germany. Nat seems just at home entertaining big crowds as he does when he takes to his boat which is tied up to a jetty at the rear of his house in Lakeland, Florida.

### JIMMY COBB Drums

Jimmy Cobb is a true legend of Jazz... his cv covers the best in the business - Miles Davis and in the 70's Jimmy toured with Sarah Vaughan.

For the past 15 years Jimmy Cobb has played drums with the Nat Adderley Quintet and the group's richer for it.

### VINCENT HERRING Saxophone

Two years ago Vincent Herring went to the Wangaratta festival as a headliner. This year Herring is back as one of a dozen top international jazz musicians at the Vic Health Montsalvat Jazz Festival.

A ten year stint at jazz clubs such as Sweet Basils saw Herring regarded as one of the Darlings of the New York set before being snapped up by Nat.

### ROB BARGAD Piano

Bob Sedergreen sums up Rob Bargad's piano playing as sweet and sophisticated.

A relative newcomer to Nat's Band, having joined just two years ago, Rob is looking forward to his first trip downunder.

### WALTER BOOKER Bass

Some people join the army to shoot or get shot... Walter Booker was smarter than most and learned to play the bass and the music world fraternity appreciate his choice of weapons.

In between army stints Walter earned a degree in Psychology... played in numerous big bands... joined Nat's Brother Cannonball band for it's last seven years... played on the soundtrack of Clint Eastwood's thriller Play Misty for Me, and is looking forward to visiting Australia, which he has been told is bigger than Texas.
