I am very pleased to inform you that you have been selected to receive a Competitive Music Scholarship from the North Texas State University School of Music for the 1985-1986 academic year. Our scholarship program is very competitive, and I would like to congratulate you for being selected for this award.

Your selection for a scholarship was based on the outstanding ability which you have demonstrated as a percussion performer, and the award which will be granted to you is the S & S Percussion Scholarship in the amount of \$200.00. One hundred dollars will be available for your fall semester registration and \$100.00 for your spring semester registration.

Under the provisions of the law recently passed by the State Legislature, we are fairly certain that if you are not a resident of the State of Texas, this scholarship will allow you to register at resident tuition rates for the complete 1985-1986 academic year, including both 1986 summer sessions. However, at the present time, we are awaiting final approval by the Coordinating Board, Texas College and University System which is charged by the State Legislature to validate all scholarship tuition waivers. Consequently, no guarantee regarding the waiver of non-resident tuition can be made at this time. I will apprise you of the status of your scholarship regarding the waiver of non-resident tuition just as soon as it is made known to us.
