I'm writing to seek your support for Gary France to join the WASO on its tour to the Northwest 10-17 October.

The tour is especially significant as the orchestra's last visit was in 1988. The impact will be substantially enhanced this time as the orchestra will perform two different concerts and a four-day educational project. It is for the latter that we would particularly benefit by Gary's unique talents.

Through the WA Ministry for Education we have organised a series of lecture/demonstrations by individual musicians in select schools in the Karratha/Port Hedland area. The local music teachers have particularly asked for one of the six musicians taking part to be a percussionist.
